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2022 Impact Award Honorees

Liesel Blau & Mia Graham

We are honored to present Liesel Blau and Mia Graham with the Council on Aging - Southern California's 2022 Impact Award for their innovative and creative support.

Operation Happy Holidays was founded in September 2017 as a Girl Scout Silver Award project to make, collect, and deliver holiday cards to older adults living in long-term care facilities every year. The founders, Liesel Blau and Mia Graham, were 11 years old and in 6th grade. They were introduced to the SmileMakers Holiday Gift Project through their Girl Scout troop leader and felt it was a cause where they could make a difference by adding handmade holiday card to every gift.



In its first year, Liesel and Mia made a video and Cardmaking Instruction Booklet which they shared online to Girl Scout Troops, Lionsheart Chapters, and local schools to raise awareness of the needs of older adults alone in long-term care facilities in Orange County and to involve young teens in helping to make holiday cards to support the SmileMakers Holiday Gift Project.

In addition to small workshops for local Girl Scout troops, the girls led a cardmaking workshop for 200 students at their middle school. Their goal was to collect 4,000 cards from the kids in their community of Ladera Ranch. The response was overwhelming. They collected over 5,000 cards! Even more exciting, they received cards from hundreds of teens from many different groups across Orange County.

On behalf of all you have done to support the Council on Aging and the SmileMakers, you have our heartfelt thanks for helping us generate thousands and thousands of smiles.

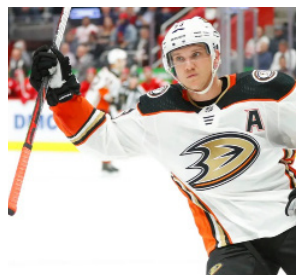

Who We Are

The Council on Aging – Southern California has been a trusted nonprofit organization since 1973. We provide unbiased information, programs and services to more than 100,000 adults and families annually.

Our Friendly Visitor Program prevents and alleviates the physical and mental health challenges of isolated, older adults and individuals with disabilities who lack an adequate support system.

Our program offers case management services and a supportive safety net of prescreened, trained volunteers who provide weekly home visits and telephone checkups.

Eligibility

- ▶ Older or dependent adults 18 years and above
- ▶ Inadequate support system
- ▶ Frail and/or homebound
- ▶ Willing to participate in the program

The ReConnect/EBOA Program provides initially and regularly responsive prevention and intervention services to change chronic conditions and are experiencing behavioral health issues, aging challenges, critical transitions later in life.

Programs Highlight By

- Change Chronic adults age 64 and older
- Limited or no supports social support
- Ability to participate in the program
- Experiencing loneliness, isolation, grief, or life-like transitions

Long-Term Care Ombudsmen are advocates for the rights of residents of skilled nursing and residential care facilities. Our mission is to empower residents through advocacy, mediation, complaint investigation and resolution.

Ombudsman services are free and confidential. Do you:

- ▶ Know your rights as a resident?
- ▶ Have concerns about quality of care?
- ▶ Suspect financial abuse?

Long-Term Care Ombudsmen are certified by the State of California to:

- ▶ Make unannounced, regular visits to licensed long-term care facilities
- ▶ Mediate, and attempt to resolve, residents' concerns
- ▶ Investigate abuse and neglect complaints
- ▶ Provide unbiased placement information and referrals regarding long-term care facilities
- ▶ Witness the signing of Advance Health Care Directives in care facilities
- ▶ Educate families and the community on long-term care issues
- ▶ Report serious facility violations to state licensing agencies
